30th Anniversary TRIP ITINERARY

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 4

Welcome aboard! Today we depart our flight to Kilimanjaro, Tanzania via Amsterdam. Some of us may find it difficult to sleep, but we encourage everyone to have a good rest. Anyone wishing to travel early to a European country for a few nights is welcome to do so. Please plan to arrive in Tanzania no later than 8 pm on Thursday, March 5 to join the group.

THURSDAY, MARCH 5

We connect to our flight in Amsterdam and arrive in Tanzania at 8 pm. On arrival, we will be met by our vans and guides and check into the River Tree Inn.

FRIDAY, MARCH 6

Today we will drive to the Mombo District where A Better World has a number of projects. We will check into the Executive Hotel.

SATURDAY, MARCH 7

We will spend time visiting A Better World projects in the Mombo District and meet some of the people who we are helping.

SUNDAY, MARCH 8

Today we will drive to Lake Manyara. It is a long drive, but the scenery is beautiful, and we will stop for a nice lunch along the way.

MONDAY, MARCH 9

We will take a picnic lunch and visit the Ngorongoro crater. In the evening we will check into the beautiful Ngorongoro Serena hotel, built on the rim of the crater, and offers an amazing view.

TUESDAY, MARCH 10

Today we will embark on a game drive in the Ngorongoro Crater.

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 11

We will fly to Nairobi to begin the Kenya portion of our trip.

THURSDAY, MARCH 12

In the morning, we will visit the elephant orphanage and depart for our two night stay at the Sopa Naivasha Resort.. This is an exclusive hideout about three hours from Nairobi toward the lake country of Kenya. The resort is located on Lake Naivasha.

FRIDAY, MARCH 13

After breakfast, we will visit our newest project. Then, we will drive to Elsmere Garden for lunch and a boat ride on Lake Naivasha. If you wish, a golf game followed by a walk around the grounds is scheduled. Many of the world's largest lakes are located in Rift Valley.

SATURDAY, MARCH 14

We will depart today for the Mara Sarova tented camp deeper into the game reserve. We will arrive at the tented camp for lunch. By virtue of its location and layout, the Camp offers an unparalleled variety of activities and experiences.

SUNDAY, MARCH 15

This morning we wake up early for a drive through the Kenyan sector of the famous Mara-Serengeti ecosystem, Kenya's most fascinating reserve. We will look for herds of elephants roaming through the trees. After breakfast, we will visit projects and have our picnic lunch at one of our schools, then enjoy a drive back through the park and end the day visiting a Maasai village.

MONDAY, MARCH 16

Today will be spent visiting our medical, water, and school projects in the Mara area.

TUESDAY, MARCH 17

Today will be an all-day game drive with a picnic lunch and, for those who wish, a hot air balloon ride. The phrase "Big Five Game" was coined by game hunters and refers to the very large mammals that were the most sought in Africa. The collection consists of the lion, elephant, buffalo, leopard, and rhinoceros. After lunch, we will proceed to the Mara Serena Lodge. The lodge has a 360-degree view of the Mara.

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 18

This morning we will spend our time in the Mara Serena area doing some game drives and enjoying our surroundings.

THURSDAY, MARCH 19

Today we will depart for Canada. We will drive from Mara to Nairobi and catch our evening flight home or **Extend the trip to Lamu Island. See below for details.**

OPTIONAL EXTENSION TO LAMU ISLAND

THURSDAY, MARCH 19

We will travel from the Mara to beautiful Lamu Island, a World Heritage site on the coast of Kenya. On arrival, we will check in to our hotel before taking a spectacular sunset dhow boat cruise on the Indian Ocean.

Friday, March 20

Lamu Island is a part of the Lamu Archipelago of Kenya. There are no roads on the island, but rather alleyways and footpaths, and therefore, there are few motorized vehicles on the island. Today we travel by boat to see the Lamu School. This is a school for children and young adults with special needs. The students don't have visitors often but love to welcome guests to their school.

SATURDAY, MARCH 21

Today we will say our goodbyes and catch our flight to Nairobi and then each to our respective homes. We are glad that you decided to travel with us and we hope we will see you again soon!
